

County-wide Millage = 122.23








No property tax rate increase.



122.23 Millage Breakdown General Fund


Board <u>decreased</u> funding by 3.34 mills for FY 2021. Areas effected:

- Building & Grounds funding cut by 7.5 percent.



Road & Bridge

- Millage will remain at 20.9 mills in 2020.
- This does not reflect the \$9.8 Million in state bridge grants the County will receive in 2020-2021.
- Grant revenue is not counted with millage/taxes.

122.23 Millage Breakdown Road & Bridge

- *Millage will remain at 20.9 mills in 2020.*
- The 20.9 mills is then divided even between all five districts
- Each district road fund will receive 4.18 mills

Road & Bridge Mills Dropped 25.55 mills to 20.9 mills over the past decade.


• These make up 15% of the millage. Virtually, no change from 2020.
