George County government offices and garbage pick-up holiday schedule

In celebration of Christmas and the holiday season, all County government offices will be closed on Dec. 24 and Dec. 25. County offices will reopen on Thursday, Dec. 26 for normal business hours. This includes the Board of Supervisors, Chancery Clerk, Circuit Clerk, Justice Court, and Tax Collector. County offices will also be closed Jan. 1 for the New Year Holiday.

George County Solid Waste crews will be running a special schedule to ensure all household garbage is picked up during the holidays.

During the week of Christmas and the week of New Year's crews will run the regular route on Monday and Tuesday, no garbage service on Wednesday, and then begin the "One Day Behind" schedule on Thursday and the remainder of the week.

To reduce litter, the Solid Waste Department crews request homeowners and businesses make sure all wrapping paper and loose packing materials are put securely inside a bag or container. Residents should place household garbage curbside as normal.

To all local veterans, the George County Veterans office will be closed from Dec. 23 through Jan 1, but will reopen on Thursday, Jan. 2 for regular hours.

For all our seniors, the George County Senior Citizens building will be closed on Dec. 24 and Dec. 25. Regular weekday lunch service will be provided on Dec. 26 and Dec 27. For the New Year's holiday they will be closed on Jan. 1.
