
Situation Overview

Tropical Storm Gordon





NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

- Tropical Storm Gordon is forecast to intensify to a Category I hurricane and likely make landfall on the MS coast this evening.
- Hurricane Warning in effect for coastal Mobile/Baldwin Counties and the adjacent coastal waters.
- Tropical Storm Warning in effect for coastal NW Florida, inland Mobile/Baldwin, and portions of inland SE Mississippi.
- Storm Surge Warning for coastal Mobile County.
- Storm Surge Watch for Mobile Bay east to Navarre, FL.
- Flash flooding, storm surge, dangerous surf, tornadoes, and strong winds are potential impacts.
- Conditions will begin to deteriorate along coastal areas by as early as midday today with conditions deteriorating inland this afternoon into tonight.






Time of Arrival

Tropical Storm Gordon






- The earliest reasonable time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds along the coast will be midday today, mainly in frequent gusts.
- However, the most likely time of arrival for Tropical Storm Force Winds will be this afternoon along the coast and this evening further inland.

Expected Storm Total Rainfall

- Greatest rain totals are likely southwest of a Waynesboro, MS to Navarre, FL line.
- Widespread 3-5 inches are expected from Santa Rosa, FL northwest into inland southeast Mississippi. Localized totals of 6-10 inches are possible.
- Sharp rainfall gradient is expected from southwest to northeast across the region.

Note: There will likely be locally higher amounts
