GC Board of Supervisors change meetings schedule

The George County Board of Supervisors is changing its regular meeting schedule to the "First and Third" Mondays of each month. Supervisor Larry McDonald (Dist. 3) proposed the change which was unanimously approved to begin this month.

"This simple change will make it easier for our residents, contractors, and vendors to keep up with the Board's calendar," McDonald explained. "Under the former schedule, our second meeting of the month could fall on any day of the week. It was especially difficult for vendors to make Friday meetings and we were constantly changing days to avoid weekends."



The Board also agreed if a "Third Monday Meeting" falls on a holiday, the meeting will automatically move to Tuesday. Coincidentally, this will be the case in February. The "Third Monday" falls on President's Day, which is a State and County Holiday. The next Board meeting will be Tuesday, February 19.

State statues only require a Board of Supervisors to meet once a month. The "First and Third" schedule is widely used across the state.

George County's Board Room is in the County's Administrative Building located at 329 Ratliff Street in Downtown Lucedale. The Board meetings start at 9 a.m. and are always open to the public. For more information on meeting schedules and agendas call 601-947-7506.
