

George County Job Opening for the Veteran Service Officer

The George County Board of Supervisors has an immediate job opening for the County Veteran Service Officer position. If interested, please submit an application by the deadline of **Friday, Oct. 18, 2024, by 10:00 am** at the County Administration Building.

This is a part-time position (three days a week on average) which reports to the Board of Supervisors, coordinates with the County's Finance Dept. and Community Development Office, and works closely with Mississippi Veterans Affairs.

This position is responsible for advising local veterans, and their dependents, of their rights, federal and state benefits, assisting them in completing Veterans Administration (VA) forms, for example: service-connected disability applications, GI Bill applications, research of military and medical records, appeal denied claims when appropriate, and all other related VA programs.

The salary range is \$14.00 to \$16.00 an hour and includes: a county office, flexible office hours, computer training, and attending Mississippi VA training conferences. The County will provide all needed workplace training for the Veteran Service Officer to earn the required VA certification.

Applicants must be a current resident in George County or willing to relocate to George County. Applicants must also be an honorably discharged veteran (any branch of the US military) or the child of an honorably discharged veteran.
